ROYALLY BRED... An \$800,000 Lexington Selected Sale yearling, One Eight Hundred is by an O'Brien and Dan Patch Award winner - Somebeachsomewhere - and out of a Dan Patch Award winner - Economy Terror.

BLAZING SPEED... As a two-year-old he paced an astonishing first half in :52.4 at The Red Mile, then came back at three, and paced a back-half at The Meadowlands in :52.2 - with a final quarter of :25.3 - the night he took his lifetime mark of 1:48.

IT'S ALL IN THE FAMILY... A multiple stakes winning three-year-old, One Eight Hundred won sub-1:49 twice that season, and has three different siblings with sub-1:50 marks as well. His dam (Economy Terror p,3,1:49f; \$1.6 million) and her full sister (Yellow Diamond p,3,1:49.4f; \$1.3 million) are both Breeders Crown winners.
