GENERAL DIRECTIVE NO. 2 – 2017 – Rescinding Enhanced Cobalt Testing Directive

Preamble

WHEREAS on April 6, 2017, the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA) announced that official samples will be tested for cobalt, commencing May 1, 2017. As a result, the AGCO's enhanced cobalt testing previously conducted pursuant to Amended General Directive No. 2/2015 is no longer required.

TAKE NOTICE, effective May 1, 2017 the Registrar hereby rescinds Amended General Directive No. 2/2015.
