R1 – All Clear

R2 – All Clear

R3 – All Clear

R4 – Inquiry, reviewed a possible pylon violation in the last turn. #4 Malnificent (Bob McClure), (finsihed 2<sup>nd</sup>) was inside two consecutive pylons in the last turn. #4 was not lapped on at the finish, no violation of the pylon rule.

R5 – Recall, a pylon was laying on the track prior to the start.

R6 – All Clear

R7 – Reviewed racing at the  $\frac{3}{4}$  pole. #7 One Tough Nerd (Alfred Carroll), (finished 7<sup>th</sup>) suffered broken equipment (hobble), made a break and interfered with #1 Matts Tuition (Bob McClure), (finished 3<sup>rd</sup>). No placings required. #1 was charted with interference at the  $\frac{3}{4}$  pole. #7 was charted with an equipment break at the  $\frac{3}{4}$  pole.
