R2 – #4 Goingwiththeflo (Justin Turcotte), was scratched during the post parade by the AGCO commission veterinarian (*vet lame*), (*refund \$824*).

Reviewed racing around the last turn between #5 Broadway Maija (Dan O'Brian), (finished 6<sup>th</sup>) and #6 Twofourroadie (Scott Young), (finished 5<sup>th</sup>). #6 hooked wheels with the #5 from behind. Driver Scott young said his horse was bearing in badly and explained that he should have given the inside horse more room. #6 finished 5<sup>th</sup> and was placed 6<sup>th</sup> for causing interference to #5 in the last turn. #5

was charted with interference, #6 was charted with an interference break.
