Driver of #1 Brett MacDonald was cautioned

regarding his urging in the stretch which was considered borderline to being a violation of the urging rules. Clear.

Inquiry, possible interference after the ½ and before the ¾; after the ½ #1 MISTER ORION (Stephane Brosseau) while off stride causes interference to #8 BETTN ON FIRE (Brett MacDonald), #8 was charted with an interference, no placing necessary as #1 finished 9th (last); before the ¾ while off stride #5 ARDYNE SPORSTAR (Stephane Pouliot) caused interference to #7 DGS ONCEUPONATIME, #8 BETTN ON FIRE and #9 SECRET COLOURS, #s 7, 8 and 9 charted with interference before the ¾, no placing necessary as #5 finished 8th (behind the horses interfered with).
