#### Office:

- Review with driver Brett MacDonald of race 6 ZINGERS LAUGH from 29 July regarding AGCO rule 22.23.01 (b) (excessive) in the stretch; the panel partially accepted the explanation of Mr. MacDonald but did inform him of the consequences of repeated violations and the escalating penalty structure, no penalty.
- Driver Phillipe Hudon was assessed a driving suspension of three days (to be served 12-14 August, inclusive) resulting from the withdrawal of his appeal of SB 50909 and the reinstatement of the driving suspension penalty (SB 50377).
- Trainer transfer approved for ELM GROVE LUCK (1MP91) from Michael Brealy to Michael Armstrong (particulars uploaded to portal).

### Races:

- On the advice of several drivers a one second variant was allowed for races 1 through 4 due to an excess amount of water applied along the rail.

- 2. Inquiry on driver of #3 KINNDER PREDICTION, Justin Filion, concerning a possible violation of AGCO rule 22.23.04 (a) (keep a line in each hand for the entire race); Mr. Filion stated that he had maintained a line in each hand for the

entire race, which was not supported by the video; #3 finished 1<sup>st</sup> and was placed last (9<sup>th</sup>) as per Policy Directive 5-2009 for violating the urging rule.

Driver Justin Filion was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.23.04 (a) and assessed a driving suspension of three day (to be served 15-17 August, inclusive) and a monetary penalty of \$200 (SB 50389) and also adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.19 (feet out of stirrups) and assessed a monetary penalty of \$100 (SB 50388). Clear.

Mr. Healey will attend the Judge's office for a review of this race relative to AGCO rule 22.05.01 (a & b) (bear down causing another driver to change course, take his horse back and impede the progress of another horse or cause it to break).
