### Report on day's events:

#### Office:

- Review with driver Kyle Forgie regarding his urging in the stretch from race 10 at Kawartha on 25 August. Mr. Forgie is now aware of what is considered permissible urging and of the penalty for any violation of the urging regulations, no penalty.
- CAVIART SUNDANCE (Matt McDonald trainer) was a Judges (other) scratch from the 8<sup>th</sup> race as this horse was administered Lasix outside of the prescribed time (AGCO rule 35.07.01).

#### Races:

- Stephane Brosseau excused from one drive.
  - Gary McDonald excused from one drive.
1. Reviewed break by #5 TOPVILLE CHROME (Gilles Gendron) after the ¾ mile pole, #5 did cause interference to #6 ROSE RUN RANGER (Jonathan Lachance) (charted with interference), no placing necessary as #5 finished 6<sup>th</sup> (last). Driver of #2 BEACH BOY, Guy Gagnon, adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.05.01 (k) (failure to set or maintain a pace comparable to class) in the second quarter (28<sup>1</sup> 58<sup>3</sup> 126<sup>4</sup> 154<sup>4</sup>) and assessed a monetary penalty of \$100 (SB 50913). Clear.

  3. Judges scratch of #4 COLLECTOR CLASSIC as this horse was entered into the

EIPH program on 13 September by the AGCO veterinarian Dr. L. Attack-Berthiaume and is ineligible to race for fifteen days (AGCO rule 25.02.06). WARKEN ON AIR #5 suffered broken equipment (head pole) after the ¾ mile pole, finished with broken equipment. Clear.

4. Driver of #2 TOP DESIRE, Gary McDonald, cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.23.04 (hands above head) in the stretch. Clear.
5. Starter Jamie Fiolek will query the drivers of #5 UNCLE BEN N (Jacques Beaudoin), #6 CHOCOLATE BISKIT (Claude LaRose) and #8 BESTOFBEST HANOVER (Stephane Pouliot) regarding their being off the gate (AGCO 22.03 (j)(vii)). Clear.
6. Late vet scratch (lame) of #2 BET I CAN FLY by the AGCO veterinarian Dr. L. Attack-Berthiaume, refund: \$5298; #2 on the vet list for 7 days (AGCO rule 20.02 (b)). Driver of #6 ROSE RUN SLIDER, Emil Toth, cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.19 (feet in stirrups) in the stretch. Clear.

8. Claiming price of #8 REBEL CHILD erroneously listed as \$7,000 while the class states: "Claiming \$15,000" which was corrected. Reviewed break by #7 ARUKIDDINMIST (Darrell Coville) before the ¼ mile pole, #7 did cause interference to #8 REBEL CHILD (Kyle Forgie) (charted with interference), no placing necessary as #7 finished 7th (last). Clear.
