Clear.
2. Inquiry on #3 LMC PICASSO (Stephane Pouliot) who finished 5th and was lapped by #2 UNSINKABLE ONE (Matt Harvey) concerning AGCO rule 18.08.02 (leaving the course) before the ¼ mile pole; #3 was inside one pylon and hit several, no advantage gained and no placing. Clear.
