Race 1 – Reviewed racing before the ¼ pole and the break of #1 “Wine Rack Hanover” (Sylvain Filion). “Susies Lady” #3 (Chris Christoforou) given an interference. “Talahasse Seelster” #4 (Eddie Green) was given an interference break.

Race 2 – All clear.

Race 3 – “McKees Angel” #3 (Sylvain Filion) goes on the Judges list for breaks.

Race 4 – “Rockrolls Shadow” #1 was a vet scratch lame-short term by the Association vet. Refund \$1,412.

Inquiry start. “Full View” #7 (Bob McClure) made a break in stride and reached the fair start pole.

Race 5 – Reviewed the stretch drive with the front tower. “Casimir Rumrunner” #5 (Sylvain Filion) the race winner gets up the inside of the 2nd place finisher Racemup” #2 (Louis Roy). Mr. Roy’s horse was visibly running out in the stretch drive. Mr. Roy did his best to correct his horse and keep him down in his lane.
