RACING CONDITIONS for 2020 BRIAN JEROME MEMORIAL CLAIMING SERIES

The Rules of Racing of the Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) in effect at the time the race is contested shall govern this race and any and all entries to the race will be received only with the understanding and on the agreement of the subscriber that the Rules of Racing govern, and that the following additional conditions apply:

- 1. Nominations due Monday October 5th, 2020. Those nominating horses to these events are responsible for eligibility.
- 2. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet.
- 3. All nomination fees will be added to the final. There will be no starting fees.
- **4.** Nomination fees must accompany all nominations. Payment for nomination fees <u>must be in Canadian funds</u> <u>only.</u>
- 5. A minimum of 14 nominations are required to fill the series. If less than 14 nominations are received, the event may proceed at the discretion of the race office.
- 6. If only 14 to 16 nominations are received, the top 8 money earners from the three legs will race in the final, if more than 16 nominations are received the top 9 money earners from the three legs will race in the final; if a tie for 9th place it will be selected by lot.
- 7. If there are more than 18 nominations received, the top 9 money earners will race in the final, the 10th-18th place money earners will race in the consolation; if a tie for 9th place it will be selected by lot.
- 8. There must be a minimum of 7 entries for the consolation. In the event that there are fewer than 7 entries, the race office reserves the right to rescind the consolation.
- 9. In the event there is no consolation, the top 9 money earners will race in the final. If a tie for 9th place it will be selected by lot.
- 10. All races will be contested at a distance of 1 mile.
- 11. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Rideau Carleton Raceway.
- 12. All events will be conducted under the rules of the AGCO and Standardbred Canada.
- 13. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Rideau Carleton Raceway.
- 14. Purse distribution: 50-25-12-8-5%.
- 15. Rideau Carleton Raceway reserves the right to refuse any and all nomination, return fees, rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of the races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an AGCO approved future race date or rescind it in which case all monies paid will be refunded. Rideau Carleton Raceway accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these or any races.
- 16. It is suggested that payments be made in person at the Rideau Carleton Race Office by Sunday, October 4th, or at the Mohawk Park Race Office by Monday, October 5th. Alternatively please use the online payment option available at www.woodbine.com/sbpayments.
