R1-Issues with the photo finish that were resolved before we went official Race clear

R2-#5 Colin Kelly urging in the stretch A warning was attached to his file. He has not had a violation since 2019.

R3- Reviewed the break of #1 Coulter (5<sup>th</sup>) before the ¼ plus pylons first and last turn No violations

R4-Reviewed the break of #6 McNair after the ¾

R5-Reviewed head of the stretch between #3 Neill and #6 Sorrie. #3 appeared to come off the back of #8 causing #6 to move over. Film inconclusive

R6- Inquiry in the first turn #1 Plante (2<sup>nd</sup>) made a break causing interference to #2 McNair (4<sup>th</sup>), #8 Sorrie (5<sup>th</sup>) and #3 Henry (7<sup>th</sup>). #1 Saulsbrook Kaiser finished 2<sup>nd</sup> placed 7<sup>th</sup> for causing interference while on a break. Spoke to the drivers involved. #1 Plante said his horse got rough but he felt there was no issues. After the 7<sup>th</sup> race Plante said he felt he was squeezed into the pylons indicated he might appeal.
