### Office:

- Complaint received from a horseperson regarding alleged misconduct towards them in the paddock; complaint will be investigated and a meeting scheduled with both parties to resolve the issue.
- Early Veterinary scratches of BIG JO (lame) from the third race and RICOTTABKIDDINME (sick) from the ninth race; these horses are entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list.
- The eligibility of GREAT SOMEWHERE in the third race was questioned based on AGCO rule 12.03 (charted line within previous 60 days); the Panel determined that this horse is eligible.
