- The time displayed for the half on the board is inaccurate on occasion; any corrected times announced to the public.

- 2. Both the #2 BARN ONE (Jimmy Gagnon) and the #4 MIDNIGHT MOOD (Pascal Berube) suffered broken equipment (choke plate after the ¾ mile pole and overcheck after the ½ mile pole, respectively); both finished with broken equipment. Clear.
- 3. The #1 ILL BEA STAR TOO (Mike Healey) suffered broken equipment (knee boot) after the ½ mile pole and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
- 4. Reviewed the performance of #6 CHARLIE BAR (Pascal Berube) who broke before the 3/4 mile pole and was off stride for more than 25 consecutive strides; #6 finished fifth (dead heat) placed seventh (last) per AGCO rule 22.27.02 (extended break). Clear.
- 5. Reviewed the break by #9 LOCHABER (Samuel Fillion) before the ¼ mile pole; while off stride #9 did cause interference to #2 ALL ABOIL (Jimmy Gagnon); no placing necessary as #9 finished posterior to #2. Clear.
