### Report on day's events:

#### Office:

- Jeff Egan, having completed 10 satisfactory qualification drives, is now eligible to drive in overnight races.
- Early Judges scratch (stable error) of QUIVERS HANOVER from the seventh race. Trainer Gary McDonald was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO 20.03.01 (i) by causing this horse to be scratched and assessed a monetary penalty of \$300 (second violation of this rule within one year) (Number 1875557).
- Early Judges scratch (transportation) of SELF ISOLATION from the eighth race.

#### Races:

1. Late Veterinary scratch (lame) of CHEQUE THE MAGIC by the AGCO veterinarian, Dr. L. Attack Berthiaume; refund: \$1397; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list and must qualify due to being a veterinary scratch in two consecutive races (AGCO rule 20.04.03). Clear.

4. Discussed race pace with the driver of #3 LOCHABER, Robbie Robinson, concerning the second quarter (29 59<sup>3</sup>); considering the explanation of the driver that the horse would not try and the few starts the horse has had, no regulatory action will be taken

although Mr. Robinson was reminded of a driver's obligation when cutting the mile and an official warning was entered on his licence. Clear.

5. Clear.
6. The #4 ROLLING IN CLOVER (Guy Gagnon) suffered broken equipment (shoe at the ½ mile pole and head pole at the ¾ mile pole) and finished with broken equipment.  
Reviewed the race pace (29<sup>2</sup> 100<sup>1</sup>) set by #1 CURRENT DANGER (Jimmy Gagnon); the panel does not consider this to be a violation of AGCO rule 22.05.01 (pace comparable to class) considering the class of race and that this horse was in front by 2-3 lengths. Clear.
7. Late Veterinary scratch (sick) of ROSE RUN YOLAE; refund: \$279; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) veterinarians list. The #2 HELLAS ROCKET (Sebastien Turenne) suffered broken equipment (knee boot) after the ¾ mile pole and finished with a flat tire. Clear.
8. Inquiry and driver's objection concerning possible interference after the start by #6 SHADOW DAVE (Mike Healey), who finished second, on #2 STRAIT TO THE POINT (Darcy Clancy), who finished sixth; Mr. Clancy claimed #6 had beared down and contacted the front leg of his horse when trying to move to the rail, which was not supported by the video; objection disallowed.

9. The #2 HOLDIN ACES (Samuel Fillion) broke before the ¼ mile pole and qualifies for breaks in two consecutive races on a fast track (trainer notified). Clear.
10. The #4 SPORT A LUCKY STAR (Mike Healey) suffered broken equipment (shoe) in the stretch and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
