Jim was a founding Director of Standardbred Canada and served three terms subsequent to the amalgamation of the Canadian Trotting Association and Canadian Standardbred Horse Society in 1998.

In December 2019, Jim was elected to Standardbred Canada as an Active Director for Ontario. He was subsequently elected Vice Chair by the SC Board and to the Executive Committee and By-Laws/Regulations/Licensing Committee. Outspoken and fearless, often putting his own
