- Educational review held with driver Robert Shepherd regarding his urging of BLUE MOOSE on 8 June; after reviewing the race video and discussing AGCO rule 22.23.03(b) (wrist action only) Mr. Shepherd recognized the fault in his urging style and will make corrections to remain in compliance.
