**Report on day's events:**

- Reminded several participants of their outstanding obligations regarding monetary penalties.

**Races:**

- Philip Reid and Pascal Berube each excused from one drive.
  - Robert Shepherd excused from two drives.
1. Reviewed the performance of #1 LIGHT THE TORCH (Jacques Beaudoin) after the start; #1 did contact several pylons; no violation of the inner rail rule. The teletimer was not functional for the first race; race fractions: 28<sup>3</sup> 58 127<sup>2</sup> 157<sup>2</sup>. Clear.
  2. Clear.
  3. Discussed crossing over abruptly after the start with the driver of #6 SPRINGBRIDGE JIM, Andrew Moore. Clear.
  4. Reviewed the start concerning possible broken equipment (shoe) before the start on #3 HOWMAC VICTOR (Marie-Claude Auger); no broken equipment was evident for #3 before the start; #3 finished with broken equipment. Clear.
  5. Reviewed the performance of #7 ROSE RUN RUDI (Ryan Guy), who finished fifth, concerning possibly leaving the course in the last turn; #7 did contact one pylon and go inside one pylon, which is not a violation of the inner rail rules. Clear.

6. Driver of #7 KEYSTONE DORAL, Jacques Beaudoin, will attend a review regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.

Reviewed the break by #2 NELSONEDDY HANOVER (Robert Shepherd) before the ½ mile pole; while off stride #2 did cause interference to #4 OFFICE JONES (Marie-Claude Auger); no placing necessary as #2 finished seventh (last); #2 qualifies for breaks in two consecutive races on a fast track (trainer notified). Clear.

Reviewed the start of #5 THRILLING TIMES (Pascal Berube) concerning possible broken equipment before the start; #5 suffered broken equipment (hobble hanger) after the start, pulled up before the ¼ mile pole and did not finish. The #2 NOSPORTSPUNINTENDED (Stephane Pouliot) suffered broken equipment (knee boot) after the start and was victorious with broken equipment. Clear.
11. Late Judges scratch (transportation) of #6 RED CAPE PARTY; refund: \$105. Clear.
