- Test strips were utilized in race three.

R1 – The Judges spoke to driver Samuel Fillion (#7 R Thinking Monster), (finished fourth) about the fractions. Opening quarter in 26.3, half in 56. There was no confusion in the backfield.

R2 – All clear.

R3 – Judges inquiry. Reviewed the break by #6 Geronimo Creek (Ed Peconi), (finished second) after the half and #7 P L Quarantine (Loic Gueriel), (finished third) before the start. There were no violations of the breaking rules by #6 or #7. #6 Geronimo Creek must qualify for two breaks in a row on a fast track. #4 Cruises Legacy (Ryan Guy), (finished eighth) finished the race with broken equipment (Buxton).

R4 – All clear.

R5 – Judges inquiry, reviewed several breaking horses after the start and going to the quarter. #5 Hamilton De Vie (Samuel Fillion), (finished first) did not violate the breaking rules. #2 RJ Flash (Samara Johnson), (finished third) did not violate the breaking rules.

R6 – The Association Veterinarian examined #8 The Opener (Brad Rae), (finished ninth) post race. The horse was cleared after examination.

R7 – All clear.

R8 – All clear.

R9 – The Judges will hold a review with Driver Isaac Waxman (#5 Flashy Dude), (finished first) concerning the fractions in this race. Quarter of 27.4 and a half of 59.4.

R10 – Inquiry, reviewed the break before the start by #3 A Handsome Face (Doug Hie), (finished sixth). #3 was not inside the fair start pole and was a refund \$1,075
