Race 6 – Reviewed racing at the half – #2 Asbraveasmymomma (Todd Ratchford) is in the two-wide lane as #4 Something Royal (J Bradley Harris) goes three-wide around #2. #2 remains in the two-wide lane and does not cause interference to #1 Cocktail Carol (Steven Hudon). No placings needed.

Race 7 – Reviewed pylons on #1 Watch Me Dance (Samuel Fillion) in the first turn, finished 4th – #1 races inside two consecutive pylons but is not lapped at the finish. No violations of the AGCO pylon rule by #1.

- Reviewed the break by #8 Southwind Maritime (Scott Coulter) in the stretch, finished 5th – no violations of the AGCO breaking rule by #8.

Race 10 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #9 Pompano Beach (Paul MacKenzie) in the first turn, finished 4th – Video shows #9 races inside two consecutive pylons and is triple-lapped at the finish.
