### RACES

Race 1 – Inquiry – Reviewed pylons on #9 Solid Nine Hanover (Mario Baillargeon) at the top of the stretch, finished 2<sup>nd</sup> – low pan video shows #9 races over the base of one pylon and inside one pylon – no violation of the AGCO pylon rule.

- Reviewed the second quarter (:26.4, :56.4) – #10 Century Komodo (Doug McNair) moves to the front in the second quarter, no violation of AGCO Rule 22.05.01(k).

Race 2 – All Clear

Race 3 – Recall – short delay for pylon adjustments.

Race 4 – Reviewed the second quarter (:27, :58) set by #7 Shoot The Whiskey (Travis Cullen). Given the track and weather conditions, Judges accepted Mr. Cullen's explanation and no penalty was assessed for AGCO Rule 22.05.01(k).

Race 5 – #7 Jacinda (Doug McNair) finished 7<sup>th</sup> placed 8<sup>th</sup> for causing an interference break to #3 One More Bet (Sylvain Filion) in the stretch.

- Following Race 5, a quartet of drivers called about the track being unsafe in their opinion because of the wet conditions and visibility concerns. Judges contacted Bill McLinchey, who notified the Judges that management decided to grade the track. After approximately 30 minutes, Judges spoke with Mr. McLinchey and Sylvain Filion, who felt the track would be okay to continue the card of racing once the track grade was completed. During the delay, the Judges consulted with Jane Rutherford from Racing Forensics and Association Vet Dr. Ballinger concerning Lasix horses. After an hour, Judges spoke to Mr. McLinchey about how much time would be required – he felt approximately 15 minutes. Once completed, the horses paraded for Race 6 and were given a short score down. Race 6 had an original post time on the tote board of 9:16 and went off at 10:46. Any trainers who wished to scratch their horses in the remaining races were granted permission for Judges scratches.

Race 7 – Inquiry – Reviewed the break by #4 Chulo (Ed Hensley) in the stretch, finished 3<sup>rd</sup> – #4 finished 3<sup>rd</sup> placed 9<sup>th</sup> for an extended break. Inquiry video unavailable.
