#### Office:

- Early Veterinary scratch (lame) of BREEDINBANKRUPSY (trainer Marc-Andre Simoneau) from the first race; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians list.

#### Races:

- Denis Audet excused from one drive.

  3. The trainer of the race winner EATAAMS SPORTSBABY, Denis Audet, will attend the Judge Office regarding the change in performance of this horse. Clear.
  4. Reviewed the performance of #5 STONEBRIDGE ROBUST (Ryan Guy); #5 broke before the start, did not have broken equipment, had passed the fair start pole when the starter released the field and did receive a fair start.

Reviewed the break by #4 ORLYS ANGEL (Pascal Berube) after the ¾ mile pole; while off stride #4 did cause interference to #6 KINNDER FIRSTCLASS (Stephane Pouliot) cause this horse to break (charted with an interference break); #4 was off stride for more than 25 consecutive strides, finished seventh placed ninth (last) for an extended break (AGCO rule 22.27.02). Clear.

5. Inquiry on #6 RITSON (Clarke Steacy) who finished fourth concerning the breaking rules in the stretch; #6 broke stretch and finish, was not lapped on by another horse and did not violate any of the breaking rules; no placing.
