1. The #8 GAMBLER GASS (Reginald Gassien) was not in position on the starting gate when the starter released the field; Starter Steve Skene accepted the explanation of Mr. Gassien and no penalty was assigned; the #8 suffered broken equipment (shoe) after the start and finished with broken equipment. The #3 NAUGHTY PURSUIT (Darcy Clancy) finished distanced and must qualify for performance (Trainer Darcy Clancy notified). Clear.

 3. Discussed race pace with the driver of #3 CODY MOMENT, Doug Hie, concerning the second quarter (28¹ 59¹ 128 156³); considering the class and the circumstances of the race Mr. Hie was cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(k) (pace comparable to class). Clear.

5. Inquiry on the race winner #3 LAYDEE FREIGHT (Doug Hie) in the last turn concerning possibly leaving the course; #3 did go inside one pylon and did not gain an advantage; no violations. Clear.

Inquiry and Driver's objection concerning possible interference by #1 BLAKESAGENT (Loic Gueriel), the race winner, on #3 BUCK N BETTOR (Reginald Gassien), who finished third, before the $\frac{3}{4}$ mile pole; after reviewing the reviewing the race video and speaking with both drivers (Mr. Gassien stated #1 came out and forced him to take his horse back; Mr. Gueriel stated he had room to come out) the objection was upheld; #2 finished first placed third for causing interference (AGCO rule 22.09).

Mr. Gueriel will attend a review regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(a) (bear out causing another driver to take his horse back). Clear.
