

Guy Gagnon:

The Gatineau, Quebec native has again dominated the 2024 Rideau Carleton season as a Trainer/Driver. The top driver on the Rideau Carleton circuit, Gagnon hit the \$1 million mark as a driver again for the third year in a row while also amassing his largest win total as a trainer in 2024. Stable stars, I Ama Rocket, The Light Speed, and All Wrapped Up have dominated the Preferred ranks. This is the first time in Gagnon's career that he has gone over the \$600,000 barrier in purses for the season, and he is sporting this highest UTRS of his career when starting more than 250 horses in the calendar year.

Carl Jamieson:

The Puslinch, Ontario native had a resurgent 2024, having his best season as a conditioner in 2024 in nearly a decade. The Jamieson barn was led by stable starts, two-year-old pacing colt Power Code, a \$40,000 yearling purchase from the Lexington Selected Sale and a multiple New Jersey Sire Stakes winner who was three for three before a private purchase saw the horse enter the care of Andrew Harris. Fifth and Five was another stand out from the Jamieson stable, the \$32,000 yearling purchase from Lexington was an Ontario Sired Stakes Gold Winner and Battle of Waterloo elimination winner. As well as the 3-year-old trotting colt, Paquet, with very few starts to his name, was the dominant trotting colt by the end of the season, capturing the O.S.S. Super Final.

Paul Langille:

The Lower Onslow, Nova Scotia native known more for driving his trainees than catch driving changed that in 2024 with a career-high in wins as a driver. Although Langielle added more driving to his workload, the stable continued that success of past years. With Paul in the bike, his stable was led by a pair of Malicious brothers, Malelovent and Malignity. Malignity sported an impressive record of 20 wins from 25 starts as a two and three-year-old in 2022 and 23. However, it was the younger full brother who made waves in 2024. Malelovent, a two-year pacing colt, was nearly perfect in 2024, finishing his season with nine wins from 10 starts, a perfect four for four in the Atlantic Canada Sired Stakes, and amassing \$\$83,087 in his first year under the lights. A late-season score in the Phil Pinkney Memorial saw Langille add another stakes win with Good Omen, which helped with yet another successful campaign as a conditioner.
