Ontario Sires Stakes – 2-year-old trotting fillies (Gold) - races 2,6

Tyler Borth excused from driving (6 drives).

Ruling #3277766 generated – Trainer Garry Merner did fail to ensure driver availability on "Stingray Deo" in race #7. Mr. Merner has been issued a \$100.00 monetary penalty. AGCO rule 17.19.

Prior to the qualifiers Austin McEneny did complete a successful rated mile.

Last night Ontario Sire Stakes (2-year-old trotting colts) has been rescheduled to next Thursday July 31st. In accordance with policy directive #1-2013, the race will be conducted as originally drawn.

Races:

Race 1 – Clear - #7 "Phillys Stranger" did finish with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 2 – Clear – reviewed racing going to the ½, #3 "Lo and Behold" (Roy 5th) no violations of the breaking rule.

#7 "Cher Hill" pulled up before the ¾'s with broken equipment (line caught in the headpole).

Race 5 – Clear - #2 "All Bets On Kelly" (McNair) made a break in stride in the stretch, must qualify for "breaks".

Also reviewed racing going to the ¾'s, #1 "A Splash Of Green" (MacDonald 8th) made a break in stride, does cause interference to #4 "Figuratively" (Jones 3rd) and #7 "Chex Mix" (Drury 7th) no placings needed.

Race 7 – "Inquiry" past the ¾'s #5 "Corona Seelster" (Davis Jr.) does come off the rail and causes interference to several horses. #5 finished 4th and placed 8th.
