Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Early Judges scratches (transportation) of MILES OF MUSCLE (Clement Authier trainer) from the third race and WASTINGNOTIME (Yannick Martel trainer) from the fifth race.
- Early Judges scratch (injured) of TRIX AND STONES (Victor Puddy trainer) from the eighth race.

Races:

1. Clear.
2. Recall due to broken equipment (chin chain wrapped around the bit) on #3 BLUE ELVIS (Ryan Guy). Reviewed the start concerning the break by #3 before the start; #3 did not have broken equipment, was well past the fair start pole when the starter released the field and did receive a fair start. Clear.
3. As there were only four starters fifth place monies were retained by the Association (AGCO rule 18.02). Clear.

6. Report from the Chief Test Inspector that #2 IMPRESSIVE DUDE (Guy Gagnon trainer), who had been selected to provide an official sample, arrived late to the

retention area; no penalty to Mr. Gagnon as after investigation it was confirmed that this horse had not been announced as a test horse after the race. Clear.

7. The #4 ROSE RUN WHY NOT (Pascal Berube) suffered broken equipment (flat tire) after the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
8. Recall due to broken equipment (overcheck) on #3 FINAL TEXT (Guy Gagnon). Reviewed racing before the ½ mile pole between #4 THE MAGIC OF LIFE (Pierre Bovay) and #5 SYNERGY S (Sylvain Lacaille); the #5 drove up where there was no room; no violations.

The #4 suffered broken equipment (brace bandage) after the ¾ mile pole and finished with broken equipment.

The driver of #5, Mr. Lacaille, will attend a review regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.

Claims:

- 8 #2 CROSSFIT (1 claim) for \$12,000 disallowed as the claimant was unlicensed by the AGCO (rule 15.07).
