Race 1 – Clear.

Race 2 – Clear.

Race 3 – Inquiry: Reviewed breaks at the start on #1 Ram (L. McClure, 2nd), #2 La I Promise (Tre. Henry, 7th), #6 J M Celebrity (D. Thiessen, 6th) and #7 Massive Victory, (Tra. Henry, 3rd). All horses received a fair start, and all breaking horses followed the breaking rules. No violations.

Race 4 – Reviewed break on #2 Lockdown Romeo (D. Thiessen, 5th) at the start. #2 did cause interference to #4 Sandoon (T. Ratchford, 4th). No placing required.

Race 5 – Reviewed pylons on #4 Handbagofcheesies (C. Gimblett, 3rd) at the top of the stretch. #4 was inside two pylons and not lapped at the finish. No placings required.

#6 Lazar Mania finished with broken equipment (wheel).

Race 6 – Clear.

Race 7 – Reviewed break on #4 Charmbro Chip (T. Smith, 6th) before the start. #4 was well inside the fair start pole.

Race 8 – Inquiry: #1 Credit Kawhi (D. Thiessen, 1P2) did bear out in the stretch and cause interference to #7 Sake Bomb (S. Fillion, 2P1). #1 was placed for causing interference to #7. Judges determined that the horse Credit Kawhi was bearing out and therefore no penalty to the driver is required.

Race 9 – Clear.

Race 10 – Inquiry x 2: (INQ1) #1 Toss of the Dice (Tre. Henry, 4th) made a break going to the $\frac{3}{4}$ pole. #1 did cause interference to #3 Beau Knight (Tra. Henry, 3rd) and #8 Great Trickster (B. Richardson, 1st). No placings required. (INQ2) #3 made a break before the $\frac{1}{2}$. No violations of the breaking rules.

Reviewed breaks of #2 Acefortyfourmagic (G. Ketros, 5th) before the $\frac{1}{4}$ and at the top of the stretch. No violations.

Reviewed breaks on #4 Life is Great (P. MacKenzie, 7th) in the stretch through the wire and before the start. #4 was off stride at the wire but not lapped, and was well inside the fair start pole.
