Thiessen, 6<sup>th</sup>) and #7 Massive Victory, (Tra. Henry, 3<sup>rd</sup>). All horses received a fair start, and all breaking horses followed the breaking rules. No violations.

Race 4 – Reviewed break on #2 Lockdown Romeo (D. Thiessen, 5th) at the start. #2 did cause interference to #4 Sandoon (T. Ratchford, 4th). No placing required.

Race 5 – Reviewed pylons on #4 Handbagofcheesies (C. Gimblett, 3<sup>rd</sup>) at the top of the stretch. #4 was inside two pylons and not lapped at the finish. No placings required.

#6 Lazar Mania finished with broken equipment (wheel).
