Driver Jody Jamieson attended the Judges' office to discuss his strategy on "R Dutchess" from Race 6 on Friday September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Although being the 1/5 favourite, he was wanting to work a similar trip as the Aug 30<sup>th</sup> race (Simcoe Stakes). The mare was a 3/5 favourite that evening and followed the same horse, Lasting Dream and overtook her in the stretch to win. That night Tim Tetrick drove. On Friday, Jamieson never did get room to get out and was disappointed with the way the race worked out. No further action required at this time.

### Races:

**Race 1:** Clear.

**Race 3: Inquiry:** #3 Seasonal (C.Christoforou) and #5 Meadowview Rothy (M.Baillargeon) after the start. #3 Seasonal steps out and catches the front foot of #5 Meadowview Rothy causing the horse to go off stride. As a result, #3 finished 4<sup>th</sup> and was placed 5<sup>th</sup> and #3 Seasonal finished 4<sup>th</sup> and was placed 5<sup>th</sup>. No penalty to driver

Christoforou as the horse caused the interference by moving out on his own.

**Race 5: Inquiry:** Unofficial winner #7 Simply The Best (L.P.Roy) came off the rail at the head of the stretch and touched the front foot of #10 Foreverafterall (D.McNair) as confirmed by the video. As a result, #7 Simply The Best finished 1<sup>st</sup> and was placed 8<sup>th</sup> for causing interference. #2 Stellrmaniplation, #5 Darlenes Angel, #6 Laydee Freight and #10 Foreverafterall were all charted with interference from the initial interference onto #10 Foreverafterall.
