Race 5 – Inquiry – Reviewed the break by #5 Remember The Alamo (James Macdonald) going to the 3/4s, finished 4th. The horse made a quick break while sitting third along the rail and the Panel ruled #5 caused interference to #6 Tip Top Cat (Yannick Gingras), #7 Oakwood Ardan IR (Jordan Stratton), #8 Taurasi (Doug McNair), and #9 Poseidon Seelster (Bob McClure). As a result, #5 finished 4<sup>th</sup> placed 8<sup>th</sup> for causing interference while on a break.

- Reviewed the break by #4 Abuckabett Hanover (Dexter Dunn) after the start. The horse broke on his own, #6 Tip Top Cat (Yannick Gingras) was charted with interference. No placings needed.

Race 6 – Elegantimage Final, Gr. 1 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the first turn for possible interference by #9 R Dutchess (Tim Tetrick) and #10 Lasting Dream (LP Roy) on #2 Global Heritage (Dexter Dunn). Mr. Dunn stated that he received pressure from outside horses, he didn't know who was at fault, but it caused his horse to be crowded and make a break. Mr. Roy stated he maintained his path on the outside, took what room was given to him and didn't crowd the #9. Mr. Tetrick stated he got into #2, but felt he was pressured from the #10 on his outside. The Panel used the Pan and Front tower shots, which showed that #9 is running in on the turn and comes down to #2, causing that horse to make a break. #10 appears to remain in the same path on the outside and the video does not support her applying pressure to #9. As a result, #9 R Dutchess was ruled at fault for causing interference to #2 and was 1<sup>st</sup> placed 11<sup>th</sup>.

Race 7 – Shes A Great Lady Final, Gr. 1 – All Clear

Race 8 – Metro Pace Final, Gr. 1 – Inquiry – Reviewed racing in the stretch between #2 Frantic Hanover (Tim Tetrick) and #3 Al Papi (Yannick Gingras). Mr. Gingras stated his horse was getting out a little and all done. He confirmed his horse was not contacted by #2 when that rival was moving out. The Panel used the low pan video, and it showed there was no conclusive evidence of any contact by #2 to the front left leg of #3. No violations.
