## Office:

Ruling #3417877: Trainer Jacob Roberts did fail to present the horse Olaf Du Lac (Race 11) for Lasix administration within the prescribed time. A \$500 monetary penalty was issued as a result of this being the third violation of AGCO Rules 35.07/35.09 within one year.

### Races:

Race 1 – Clear. #1 Miss Party Girl finished with broken equipment (hopple hanger) #6 Bree Is A Baroness lost a shoe and made a break – charted with an equipment break.

Race 2 - Clear.

Race 3 – Inquiry: #3 Run This Town (S. Wray, 1P2) did go inside two consecutive pylons and over one pylon in the final turn. #3 was lapped by #1 All Lynn (G. Rooney, 2P1) at the finish. #3 was placed for a pylon violation.

Race 4 – Inquiry: #7 For All You Know suffered broken equipment (hopple) before the start and made a break. Complete para-mutuel refund \$1225. #7 was charted with an equipment break,
