Outrider Marie Brooking did an excellent job getting the operator to move outside, avoiding a possible accident. #4 Pullaway Ace (4<sup>th</sup>) driven by Kelly Hoerdt was given an interference as the horse started to slow up after seeing the tractor by the outside fence. #9 Gotchabythetoga (8<sup>th</sup>) finished with BE (flat tire).
