Project Overview

HRBC is planning for the inaugural harness racing meet in the Fall of 2026 at Osoyoos Desert Park. The initial racing schedule will be 10+ race days and is expected to run two days per week for a period of 5 to 6 consecutive weeks.

Purses are expected to be very competitive with Alberta and will also include some stakes races.

The climate in Osoyoos is mild with little precipitation. The barns are in good shape with about 100 stalls now and an additional 50+ new stalls planned for opening. Accommodations in Osoyoos are very reasonable with trailer parks, hotels and short-term rentals (i.e. Airbnb) with plenty of availability in the fall (off season).
