R1 – Reviewed racing after the 1/2 where #2 Philly's Stranger (T. Jones, 7th) makes a short break. Also reviewed the break of #8 Night Wash before the start. No violations.

Following Race 1, we received a late vet scratch (lame) for Race 6 on #8 Nevada Dragon. The horse must qualify as the result of two vet scratches in a row. Trainer Ryan Guy was notified.

R2 – Clear.

R4 – Reviewed the finish where #4 Julius Hanover (M. Whelan, 3rd) does drive up on #8 Rebull (B. Galliers, 2nd) and briefly hooks the wheel of #8 right at the wire. No placing required.

R5 – Recall charged to #8 Ontop Rainman (M. Whelan, 6th). Winner #4 Total Stranger (B. Galliers) took the lead to the 1/4, fought off a challenge through the 1/2, and won the race by six lengths setting fractions of 26.4, 54.4, 123.2, 152.2. Noting the horse's back class, the Judges did speak with the trainer about the performance and were satisfied with Jared Mann's explanation.

R9 – INQUIRY. Reviewed pylons in the first turn on #9 Captain Butler (D. Maclellan, 4th). He was inside one, over one, and inside one. No violation.
