Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office: Driver Brett Macdonald was found in violation of AGCO Rule 6.02(a), did fail to drive the horse Longshot Panic in Race 5 last night. \$100 monetary penalty.

Jody Jamieson was excused from two drives. (Races 9,10)

Races:

Race 1: #5 On Time Delivery and #9 Early Play finished 2nd in a dead heat.

#4 Hes Swift was placed on the Short-Term Vet's List (lame) post race by the Official Veterinarian.

Trainer Jay Polifroni was found in violation of AGCO 6.20(b), misconduct in the best interests of racing as he was not available to have his horse vet checked by the Official Veterinarian after the horse left the test barn. \$300 monetary penalty. Ruling to be generated tomorrow.

Race 2: Driver Tyler Borth was found in violation of AGCO Rule 22.05.01(e), did allow another horse to pass needlessly on the inside in the stretch while driving Sid The Kid. \$200 monetary penalty. Ruling #3660836.

Race 3: Clear.

Race 4: #3 Skylar finished with broken equipment. (martingale)

Race 5: Clear.

Race 6: #1 Titanic Hanover and #4 Always B Sweetest were charted with interference from the break of #3 One Can Dan after the quarter pole.

Race 7: **Inquiry:** Race winner #6 Osceola (D.McNair) left the rail from the three hole as #4 Usain Hanover was advancing on the outside. #4 Usain Hanover made a break. After further review the judges determined that #6 Osceola had already angled out and established position off the rail. #4 Usain Hanover was charted with an interference break as it was tight racing.
