Driver Samuel Fillion was excused from 5 drives this evening.

**Races:**

Race 1 – Reviewed pylons on #5 Miss Mass Appeal (D. McNair, 3<sup>rd</sup>) after the ¾ pole. #5 was over one pylon and inside one pylon consecutively on two occasions from the ¾ pole to the final turn. No advantage gained. Also reviewed break on #3 Kenogami Fancy (J. MacDonald, 7<sup>th</sup>) before the ¼ pole – no violations.

Race 2 – Clear. #2 Palladium Hanover grabbed a shoe and made a break before the half. Finished with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 3 – Reviewed pylons on #2 Rare Legacy (J. MacDonald, 2<sup>nd</sup>) going to the ½. #2 was over one pylon and inside one pylon. No violations.

#7 Sweet Mama made a break before the ¾ pole and must qualify for breaks.

Race 4 – Clear.

Race 7 – Clear.

Race 8 – Clear. #3 Canukepasecret (J. Jamieson, 7<sup>th</sup>) made a break going into the stretch and must qualify for breaks.

Race 9 – Reviewed pylons on #3 Punchesinbunches (M. MacDonald, 6<sup>th</sup>) and #5 All Bets On Gary (L. Roy, 7<sup>th</sup>) going into the stretch. Both horses were inside two consecutive pylons and were not forced to do so. #5 was lapped on to #3 but no other horses were lapped on. No change required.

Race 10 – Inquiry: #1 Sugar Man (L. Roy, 2<sup>nd</sup>) was inside two consecutive pylons in the stretch turn and lapped by #2 Bruno No No No (D. McNair, 3<sup>rd</sup>) and #5 Fifth And Five (J. MacDonald, 4<sup>th</sup>). Roy stated that he was pressured going into the pylons by #2. McNair stated that he left room for #1. Video review supported Roy's statement. No placing and #1 was charted with interference.

#9 Saba Rock (9<sup>th</sup>) made a break before the half and interfered with #7 Ayeaye Captain Deo (5<sup>th</sup>). #4 Lite Up The World (8<sup>th</sup>) made a break after the half and interfered with #6 Fallout (7<sup>th</sup>) and #8 Rick Wink (6<sup>th</sup>).
