### RACES

Race 1 – All Clear. #5 Kaptainkrave must qualify for three consecutive breaks, Tr. Brenda Lane.

Race 2 – Reviewed pylons on #6 Lets N Joy N (James Macdonald) around the final turn, finished 1<sup>st</sup> – hits multiple pylons but does not race inside any pylons, no violations of the AGCO pylon rule.

Race 3 – Inquiry X 2

- Inquiry #1 – Reviewed pylons on #6 Betterdoubledown (Bob McClure) approaching the finish, finished 4<sup>th</sup> – #6 hits the base of one pylon and races inside the last pylon before the wire. The Panel ruled #6 did not gain an unfair advantage by passing another rival while inside that pylon and therefore was not in violation of the AGCO pylon rule.

The interference occurred after the start and all horses were ruled to have received a fair start. No placings needed.
