Race Report

- **Race1:** Clear (Photo–Place).
- **Race2: Inquiry.** Reviewed two breaking horses in the first quarter. #3 Oceanview Gambler made a break and interfered with #5 Dustylane Margo. No placings required. #1 West River Karuna, the race winner, made a break going to the 1/4. No violations of the breaking rule.
- **Race3: Inquiry.** #1 Code Three was inside more than three consecutive pylons. Horse finished last; no placings required. Todd Hardy (2A757) – Rule 332(2) Pylons. \$50 Fine.
- **Race4:** Clear.
- **Race5: Inquiry** (Photo–5th). Two inquiries reviewed. At the 1/8, #1 made a break on his own and interfered with #3 and #4. No placings required. At the 7/8, racing action became tight near the top of the stretch between #3 and #8. Both drivers were interviewed. No violations.
- **Race6:** Clear (Photo–Show).

- **Race13: Inquiry.** #2 Lady Llamrei raced inside three consecutive pylons while fading at the back of the field. The horse was out of contention. No Penalty
