Races:

Race 1: #10 Major Perry N, finished 8th, was charted with interference from the break of #8 Momas Son Byrne, finished 10th, after the half mile mark. No placings needed.

#8 Momas Son Byrne was placed on the Short-Term Vet's List (lame) post race by the Official Veterinarians.

Race 2: Clear.

Race 3: **Inquiry:** #10 Greenarrow Hanover made a break before the start, was inside the fair start pole.

Race 4: #9 Asiago Seelster made a break before the start but was well inside the fair start pole.

Race 5: Reviewed the break of #8 Logan Park after the three-quarter pole.

#3 Usain Hanover made a break in the stretch and through the finish, finished 5th and was placed 7th for being double lapped on at the finish. #6 Sid the Kid was placed 6th and #5 French Wine was placed 5th.

Race 6: Clear.

Race 7: **Inquiry:** #8 Bravo Angel S (J.Barlett), finished 2nd and was placed 10th, for causing interference to #2 Monalishi (J.Jamieson) around the first turn before the quarter pole. The judges determined that #2 had established position to the outside #1 Stormont Beautiful who was on the rail, #8 Bravo Angel S was outside of #2 Monalishi, and the wheel of #8 Bravo Angel S contacted the right foot of #2 Monalishi causing the horse to go off stride.

Race 10: #3 Loua Dipa advanced along the rail from the two hole to win, no penalty to Dexter Dunn, driver of #5 Be Perfect Bg, finished 2nd, as the filly was drifting out.

#2 Sangria Summer (B.McClure), finished 4th, angled off the rail to the outside from tight quarters but had sufficient room to do so.

Race 11: Reviewed racing coming out of the turn after the quarter, #3 Odds On Mr Mamba had already started off the rail when #4 Sweet Lovin Lou was advancing on the outside.

Race 12: #5 Liquid and #7 Just Givener finished 4th in a dead heat.

#6 Exactly Correct finished with broken equipment. (shoe)

#1 Hall Of Fear must qualify for performance. The horse was taken off the racecourse around the last turn.
