### Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents) ....

### Office:

- Early Judges scratches (transportation) of SEVEN IRON from the fifth race and SMLSLIKETEENSPIRIT from the tenth race (Robert Jarvis trainer) and LENYS GIRL (Dwayne Hay trainer) from the sixth race.
- Early Judges scratch (weather) of BEACH ROLLER (William Gibson trainer) from the eighth race.
- Early veterinary scratches (sick) of CRAZY HORSE CREEK (Barry Bird trainer) from the fourth race and TORSTON (Brian Peterson trainer); these horses are entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians list.

### Races:

1. Late Veterinary scratch (lame) of CONTINUUM by the Official Veterinarian Dr. Gilson; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians list; refund: \$2096.. Clear.
2. Late Judges scratch (retention) of TOAST THE COAST (Michel Lagace trainer); considering the explanation of Mr. Lagace no penalty for violation of AGCO rule 26.12 is applied; refund: \$13.

Reviewed racing between #6 DENIMDAN DELIGHT (Nicholas Boyd), the race winner, and #7 LEBOY (Blair Burgess), who finished second; after the half mile #7 did bear off the rail and brush the wheel of #6 but did not impede the progress of this horse; no

placing required. Mr. Burgess was cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.23.01(b) (excessive action). Clear.

3. Clear.
4. Inquiry on the race winner #8 ONE LUCKY BEACH (Ryan Guy) concerning the breaking rules; #8 broke before the ¼ mile pole, did not violate any of the breaking rules and did not interfere with any other horse; no change to the order of finish. The #3 HIRO HANOVER (Reg Gassien) suffered broken equipment following a break at the start and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
- Post parade delayed due to three heats of canine races featuring Dachshund, Corgi and All Canadian (mixed breed) dogs. Racing continued after the sixth and eighth races.
5. Inquiry at the start concerning possible interference to #9 GIM HANDSOME (Gord Brown) by #1 GIVE ME KARETS (Mike Healey); after reviewing the race video and speaking with Mr. Brown it was determined that #1 broke at the start and did interfere with #9 after the start; no placing required. Clear.
6. Clear.
7. Late Judges scratch (retention) of STAY HUMBLE as the trainer (Austin McEneny) did fail to present this horse at the appointed time to receive Lasix in violation of AGCO rule 35.07.07; considering the explanation of Mr. McEneny no penalty is applied; refund: \$6. Clear.
8. Clear.
9. Reviewed the stretch concerning a possible violation of AGCO rule 22.05.01(e) (allow a horse to pass needlessly inside) concerning #3 KAPTAINKRAVE (Nick Boyd) allowing the race winner #3 SWEET LAKE (Ryan Guy) to pass on the inside; no penalty to Mr. Boyd as #3 was tiring and bearing out in front. Clear.
10. Reviewed the break by #5 ALWAYS ADELE (William Roy) at the start; while off stride #5 did cause interference to #4 MY LITTLE CHLOE (Gord Brown) and #7 COVE BEACH (Ryan Guy); no placing necessary as #5 finished last. Clear.
