Report on day's events:

Office:

- Report received from Racing Manager Lindsay Bax concerning incidents in the paddock on 8 August between various participants. The panel will interview and follow up with those involved.
- Review held with driver Jeffrey Hunt concerning a possible violation of AGCO rule 22.19 (foot out of stirrup) while driving PREMIER DELIGHT in the seventh race on 18 July; after reviewing the race video and discussing the rule requirements Mr. Hunt was adjudged guilty of violating AGCO rule 22.19 and assessed a \$100 monetary penalty (first violation of this rule within one year) (Number 3856076).
- Early Judges scratches (ineligible) of WELL SAID CELEB (Mitchell Tierney trainer) from the tenth race.

Races:

1. Reviewed the performance of #9 COLD CREEK NACHO (Gord Brown) at the start; #9 did break independently before and after the start; no violations. Clear.
2. The driver of #5 BAD BETTING, Dale Spence, was queried as to why this horse was not in position behind the gate and stated the horse was hesitant to approach the gate and stated he will endeavour be in proper position in the future. Clear.
3. The driver of #6 CAPITANO ITALIANO, Jordan Comegna, was cautioned and instructed regarding his urging during the race and had an official warning entered on

his licence pertaining to AGCO rules 22.23.01(b) (excessive) and 22.23.02(a) (urging when not in contention). Clear.

4. Start delayed as an equipment repair (shoe) was required on #9 HARDOO PARKING (Darcy Clancy). Clear.

6. The #8 STORMONT FULLALIFE (Nicholas Ahern) must qualify for breaks in consecutive races on a fast track (trainer notified). The #9 LET IT RIP (Blair Burgess) must qualify for breaks in three consecutive races (trainer notified). Clear.

Inquiry on the start of the race; at the start the inside wing of the starting gate did swing back 180° towards the field when the gate was accelerating away from the field; after speaking with Starter Steve Skeen and reviewing the race video it was determined that no horse was interfered with and all horses received a fair start.
