Report on day's events:

(Accidents, claims, fines and/or suspensions, objections and/or disqualifications, refunds and any other pertinent incidents)

Office:

- Five divisions of Ontario Sires Stakes Prospect series (three for three year old filly and two for three year old colt trotters) and three divisions of OSS Grassroots trotting series for three year old colts).
- Early Judges scratch (transportation) of SAVOUR THE MOMENT (Jeff Williams trainer) from the ninth race.

Races:

- Guy Gagnon excused from seven drives.
1. Reviewed racing going to the ½ mile pole between #5 COLD CREEK COTIJA (Austin Sorrie) and #3 FRIYAITSBEACHAY (Aidan Dicks); #5, cutting the mile, did bear out three wide and come back down to the rail in front of #3 without causing interference; no change to the order of finish. #5 suffered broken equipment (vet wrap) after the ¾ mile pole and was victorious with broken equipment. Clear.
 2. Clear.
 3. The driver of #2 STORMONT MY BOY, Ryan Guy, was cautioned regarding his urging in the stretch. Clear.
 4. Late veterinary scratch (lame) of STORMONT CHEERIO (Ryan Guy trainer) by the AGCO Veterinarian; this horse is entered on the short term (seven days) Veterinarians list; refund: \$15. Clear.

5. Clear.
6. Inquiry concerning possible interference by #8 IN THE BLACK (Bradley Harris), who finished fourth, on #7 ANOTHER GREAT MASS (Gord Brown), who finished sixth, in the stretch; after reviewing the race video, which was inconclusive, and speaking with both drivers (Mr. Brown stated it was tight racing without contact to his horse and Mr. Harris claimed he had maintained a straight course) there was insufficient evidence of interference warranting a placing; no change to the order of finish. Clear.
7. The driver of #4 TIMELESS, Steve Byron, was cautioned regarding AGCO rule 22.05.01(k) (pace comparable to class concerning the second quarter (28¹ 59³). Clear.

9. Reviewed the performance of #7 BARBADIAN BREEZE (Samuel Fillion) after the ½ mile pole; while cutting the mile #7 did leave the course and go inside more than three consecutive pylons; Mr. Fillion stated his horse did not feel right and he left the course to be safe; #7 finished seventh placed eighth (last) per AGCO rule 18.08.02(b) (a horse inside three or more consecutive pylons shall be placed last); #7 was examined by the AGCO Veterinarian post race who reported no issues; #7 finished distanced and must qualify for performance (trainer notified). Clear.
10. Clear.
11. The #5 broke before the ¾ and thereafter suffered broken equipment (shoe) and finished with broken equipment. Clear.
12. Reviewed the breaks by #8 ABBY ROSE MEN (Ryan Guy) and #7 ANGELINA DUHARAS (Samuel Fillion); both horses broke of their own volition; no interference. Clear.
13. Clear.

Claims:

- 13 #3 TELLIT RUSS TELLIT (one claim) for \$8,000 by John McQueen, Greg Tuckwell & Martin Migneault (Cameron McQueen trainer). This horse was not observed post race as the claimants opted out from the claim observation period.
