Driver Jonathan Drury was excused from two drives, and driver Travis Henry was excused from one drive this afternoon.

Races:

Race 1 – Clear.

Race 2 – Clear.

Race 3 – Clear. #5 Zippennrippen (N. Boyd, DNF) pulled up after the half and must qualify for performance. #5 was also put on the short-term vet list (sick). #8 Thunderbolt Run finished with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 4 – Clear. #5 Summer Lovn finished with broken equipment (shoe).

Race 5 – Recall: #2 suffered broken equipment.

Race 6 – Inquiry: #3 Sweet Cheeseus (B. Galliers, 7P8) made a break before the start and caused interference to #2 Azucar Jack (Tra. Henry, 8P7) who also broke stride. #2 was charted with an interference break before the start. Complete pari-mutuel refund of #2. #8 Kevndan Fraudster (N. Boyd, 5th) was also charted with interference after the start.

#3 made several breaks during the race and the judges were notified that the horse had finished with broken equipment (hobble) by the paddock judge. The judges were later notified after making the race official that the horse has gone to it's knees in the infield during the recall and had come out of the hobble then. #3 was charted with an equipment break before the start.

Race 7 – Clear.

Race 8 – Inquiry: #4 All Bets On Me (J. Jamieson, 3rd) made a break going to the quarter pole. No violations.

Race 9 – Inquiry: Going to the $\frac{3}{4}$ pole, #3 Will Farroh (D. McNair, 1st) moves off the pylons slightly as #1 Cherry Bomber (Tre. Henry, 6th) is advancing on the outside and then breaks stride. Driver Henry stated that #3 did not cause any interference to his horse. Video replay was inconclusive. No violations.

Race 10 – Inquiry x 2 – INQ1: #2 Just Keep Flying (Tre. Henry, 4th) made breaks before and after the half. No violations of the breaking rules. #2 must qualify for breaks.

INQ2: #6 Dewitt For Jolous (J. Jamieson, 2nd) made a break going to the $\frac{1}{4}$ pole. No violations of the breaking rules.
