Races:

Race 1 – Inquiry: #6 The House of Cash (T. Jones, 4th) made a break before the start. No violations.

Race 2 – Clear.

Race 3 – Inquiry: #3 Miss Party Girl (D. MacLellan, 3rd) made a break before the quarter pole. #3 did cause interference to #6 All Bets On Leigh (T. Borth, 2nd) who was charted with interference. No placing required.

#7 Getwokeorgobroke made a break at the quarter pole and pulled up. The horse must qualify for breaks and performance. #7 was also put on the long-term vet list lame by the Official Veterinarian.

Race 4 – Inquiry: #2 Majestic Eva (Tre. Henry, 3rd) made a break after the start. No violations.

Race 5 – Reviewed pylons on #8 Marc It Up (Tre. Henry, 2DH) going to the half. #2 was inside one pylon and over one pylon. No violations.

Race 6 – Inquiry x 2: INQ#1 - #5 Houstonweavaprobldm (T. Jones, 1st) made a break in the stretch and through the wire. #5 did not violate any of the breaking rules and was not lapped on at the wire. No placing required.

INQ#2 - #6 TH Francesca (A. Haughan, 4th) made a break going to the ¼ pole. No violations of the breaking rules.
