On August 12, 2012, the Judges issued Official Ruling SB 44882 wherein Sylvain Fillion ("FILLION") was issued a \$300 fine and a five-day driving suspension for violation of Rule 36.08 (b) (i) of the Rules of Standardbred Racing on August 12, 2012 at Flamboro Downs.

On August 14, 2012, FILLION filled a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 24.01 (b) of the Rules of Standardbred Racing.

On September 24, 2012, a Panel of the Ontario Racing Commission ("ORC"), comprised of Chair Rod Seiling, convened for the purpose of hearing this matter.

Brian Newton appeared on behalf of the Administration for the ORC. Robert Burgess attended as counsel for FILLION.

Counsel Burgess indicated that he wished to withdraw the appeal on behalf of FILLION. The request was granted. FILLION will pay the \$300 fine and is accessed additional costs of \$250 which are due upon completion of his suspension. FILLION will serve the five-day driving suspension, September 30, 2012 through October 4, 2012, inclusive.

A transcript of the Panel's Oral Reasons for Decision is attached to this Ruling.
