ORC invites individuals to apply for participation on Working Groups

In the fall of each year, the ORC conducts a review the Rules of Racing to address any necessary changes for the coming racing season. As part of that process, the ORC seeks submissions from the industry, either from the associations, licensees or from the public at large. Working groups made up of industry representatives are formed each year to review the submissions before they are submitted to the Board of the ORC for consideration.

Working Groups to be formed

The Executive Director establishes breed specific Rule Amendment Working Groups to review the proposals and provide the Administration with input and advice.
